Re: The New Orleans Advocate as Official Journal for Clerk of Civil District Court's Office

Pursuant to La. R.S. 43:201.1, effective June 29, 2018, the Clerk of Civil District Court's Office has selected The New Orleans Advocate as its official journal for all advertisements required to be made in relation to judicial proceedings. Beginning August 1, 2018, all advertisements required to be made in relation to judicial proceedings for the Clerk's Office shall be placed in The New Orleans Advocate.

The New Orleans Advocate will print judicial advertisements at the rate of \$0.19 per agate line. Additionally, all judicial and legal ads will be posted online at no extra charge, at The New Orleans Advocate's website www.theadvocate.com.

The advertisements have to be received by The New Orleans Advocate thirty-six (36) hours prior to the publication date. You can submit your advertisements for publication by email to The New Orleans Advocate. Below are the details:

- To submit your advertisements to The New Orleans Advocate via email, you would email it to Yvette Dellucky, Media Sales Consultant. The advertisements should be sent as an attachment to Ms. Dellucky at ydellucky@theadvocate.com. The New Orleans Advocate prefers that the attachment be a Word document. A pdf document is also acceptable.

Additionally, pursuant to La. R.S. 43:202, advertisements in auxiliary journal are required. The auxiliary journal remains the Louisiana Weekly.
