
**MOTION TO CLOSE THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK

R.S. 1:55 so that such closure will be considered a legal holiday so that prescription will be interrupted as to all lawsuits to be filed with her office on the aforesaid date, and on further suggesting to the Court that written approval was given by the Chief Judge of Civil District Court and was followed by written approval of the Chief Judge of the Civil District Court was given as required by the statute to authorize such a closure. The office shall re-open on Tuesday, January 9, 2024.


